

Admissions process for Year 7 entry in 2022

- 1) We welcome families for individual visits throughout the year and we also host regular open days. Our next open day is on Friday 1 October. Please <u>click here</u> to register your interest in attending the Open Day or email admissions@holmwood.house to make an appointment to visit.
 - 2) Register for a place and pay the £50 registration fee.
- 3) Registered pupils can join us for a taster day in the autumn term when they can experience what life at Holmwood House is like. Our next Taster Day will take place on **Thursday 30 September**.
 - 4) All registered pupils will be invited to an interview with the Headmaster. This will include an opportunity to discuss with the Headmaster a project or piece of work (not necessarily academic) of which they are proud. This interview will feed into the overall assessment result.
- 5) Pupils will be asked to sit an entrance assessment the week commencing 15 November 2021, completing English, Maths, Verbal and Non-Verbal Assessments.
 (Holmwood House welcomes pupils with a broad range of abilities and the assessment is used for setting purpose).
 NB Late applicants will be able to sit the entrance tests on an alternative date.
 - 6) Pupils performing particularly well in the entrance test may be considered for an academic scholarship and parents will be informed accordingly.
 - 7) Offers of places will be issued in **December 2021**.
- 8) Pupils who wish to be considered for a sport or creative arts scholarship should indicate this on their registration form and should submit supporting documents by 31 December 2021. Assessments will take place in January/February.
 - 9) The deadline for the acceptance of places is March 2022.
 - 10) A programme of induction will commence in the summer term.
