

Admissions process for Year 7 entry in 2022

 We welcome families for individual visits throughout the year and we also host regular open days. Email admissions@holmwood.house to make an appointment to visit.

- 2) <u>Register</u> for a place and pay the **£50** registration fee.
- Registered pupils are invited to join us for a taster day when they can experience what life at Holmwood House is like.

4) All registered pupils will be invited to an interview with the Headmaster. This will include an opportunity to discuss with the Headmaster a project or piece of work (not necessarily academic) of which they are proud. This interview will feed into the overall assessment result.

5) Pupils will be asked to sit an entrance assessment, completing English, Maths, Verbal and Non-Verbal Assessments.

(Holmwood House welcomes pupils with a broad range of abilities and the assessment is used for setting purpose).

- 6) Pupils performing particularly well in the entrance test may be considered for an academic scholarship and parents will be informed accordingly.
 - 7) Offers of places will be issued. Places are secured upon payment of a deposit.
- Pupils who wish to be considered for a sport or creative arts scholarship should indicate this on their registration form and should submit supporting documents by 31 December 2021. Assessments will take place in January/February.
 - 9) The deadline for the acceptance of places is **11 March 2022**. *(late applications will be considered)*
 - 10) A programme of induction will commence in the summer term.
